

Bidding Screen and Appraisal Data

Not long ago, a sizeable new feature was added to ITrack Pro, and I'll bet you didn't even notice!

In addition to the new teardown tab you may have noticed on the vehicle screen, the vehicle screen also gained a new magical bidding mode!

Most ITrack users buy trucks to sell for parts. The new bidding mode on the vehicles screen is designed to give you an idea of how much a vehicle is worth (based on the parts), before you purchase it. The information is based off of your sales history and information from HeavyTruckParts.Net.

And that isn't all!!

For an additional \$50 per month (or save and pay \$500 upfront per year) the bidding, teardown, search, and parts screen will also display the historical salesprice information from Berryhill Auctioneers auctions!!

Our relationship with Berryhill Auctioneers has allowed us to offer historical sales information from the premier truck parts auction service in the U.S.

Berryhill and ISoft felt the monthly fee was necessary to continue to improve the Auction Data Service, yet was also very affordable compared to other appraisal services.

ITrack Pro Updates

Updates are posted in both the monthly newsletter and online in the ISoft Wiki. To view the Pro updates click on "Help" and then "Recent changes to ITrack" while in ITrack Pro. Online, visit the wiki at wiki.isoftdata.com and click on ITrack Pro, then click on Recent Changes to ITrack Pro.

Vehicles

Added: Teardown tab will now remember your previously used column order. (Bug 1713)

Fixed a bug where pressing Save & New on a vehicle and then attempting to open up another vehicle would cause the "Do you want to save?" dialog to appear. (Bug 1790)

Fixed a bug where sales estimates would not be calculated for parts that didn't use Manufacturer and Model. (This should make the Sales estimate column useful for most car yards.)

Fixed a bug where the email dialog would not populate properly with part information. (Bug 1726)

Fixed a bug where some information on the Costs tab would not be cleared off after a Save & New. (Bug 1723)

Fixed a crash that would occur if a user attempted to create a cost without selecting a cost type on the Costs tab. (Bug 1795)

Fixed a bug that could cause duplicate vendors to be created.

Database

Fixed a bug where zip-codes that starting with zero had all their leading zeros removed.

Vehicles Cont.

Added: Automatic pricing(if enabled) will now be applied for parts are created using the teardown tab. (Bug 1704)

Automatic pricing can be configured in Edit > Options > Pricing tab.

Added: Default pricing(if enabled) will now be applied for parts are created using the teardown tab. (Bug 1793)

Default pricing can be configured per model/category on the Part Configuration screen > Part models tab > bottom right Default pricing section.

Transaction List

Added: Ability to export lists by right clicking in the list. (Bug 1805)

Export the all items in the list.

Export the selected rows.

General

Minor bug fixes made to the status bar.

Sales Estimate

Added: Manufacturer dropdown will now populate with the list of Vehicles makes if the part type selected isn't set to use manufacturer and models.

Fixed a bug where the Current Inventory section would not populate with information.

Holiday Hours

eBay Module

The eBay Module allows users to track their eBay listings directly from ITrack.

Users can create a list of parts from ITrack's inventory to sell on eBay.

Information entered into ITrack about the parts will automatically carry over to the eBay listing and changes can be made to part information before exporting. The eBay module also export to Turbo Lister.

The new eBay module free demo is available now in ITrack. The demo lasts now through the end of March, 2011. If you wish to continue using the eBay module after that time, you will need to contact ISoft Data Systems.

The eBay module is \$25 per month. Please contact Jake at (800) 929-1829 for more information or to order the eBay module.

(Note: You will not be charged unless you subscribe, however eBay module access won't be available after March 31 unless you subscribe.)

All Screens

Changes to various user interface elements on all screens to improve the overall user experience.

Buttons are now inactive when they can't be used with useful tooltips for the user. (Mouse-over inactive buttons for tooltips)

This results in far fewer "error" dialogs and a more streamlined user experience.
