

UPS & FedEx Integration

Now your ITrack system can integrate more closely with your UPS Worldship and FedEx shipping software.

Shipping addresses can be pulled directly into your shipping software by simply typing in the ITrack Invoice # or Quote #.

Additionally, tracking information may be pushed back into ITrack to allow you to look up tracking information for your customers without leaving ITrack.

ITrack LX

ITrack LX and LXE are now available!

ITrack LX (for ITrack Pro) and ITrack LXE (for ITrack Enterprise) allow you to use ITrack on mobile scanning devices.

Pricing for the software is \$450 for ITrack LX plus \$45 per month. ITrack LXE is \$950 plus \$45 per month.

You can purchase a scanning device from ISoft or we can assist you in purchasing a compatible device from another vendor.

ITrack Pro Updates

Updates are posted in both the monthly newsletter and online in the ISoft Wiki. To view the Pro updates click on "Help" and then "Recent changes to ITrack" while in ITrack Pro. Online, visit the wiki at wiki.isoftdata.com and click on ITrack Pro, then click on Recent Changes to ITrack Pro.

General

Users can now decide if they want enter to move to the next field(in most cases).

This can also be changed at any time by going to Edit > Options > General tab > bottom most checkbox.

Enter will now perform operations in more places.

Most buttons that open a dialog when pressed now have ... at the end of their button text.

Fixed a bug where buttons in ITrack weren't friendly enough.

Vehicles

Added Insurer and Insured fields on the Info tab.

Fixed an issue where costs could get duplicating in a rare case. (Bug 2045)

Interchange

Fixed a bug where the user was unable to tab out of the part type field once they had selected a part type.

Part Configuration

Changed: The error message that appears when a user attempts to add a make/model that already exists is friendlier. (Bug 2055)

Parts

Fixed a bug where the Interchange dialog would appear multiple times after the user selected an interchange option.

Added: users can now use Alt+V followed by Alt+C to very quickly check/uncheck the "Print Tag from Search" checkbox on the Advanced tab.

Alt+B will get the user back to the Basic tab.

Fixed an issue where the checkboxes at the bottom of the Advanced tab would be no longer visible for some users.

Fixed a bug where the interchange number would not be automatically filled out when only a single interchange option was available.

Fixed a bug where the more fields would not get reset/cleared in certain cases. (Bug 2071)

Appraisal

Fixed an issue where appraisals from the Search screen would always fail.

New Cross-Reference Support in HTP.Net

You may have noticed some new Manufacturers and Models on HTP lately.

You may have also noticed that searching for those brings up Models that aren't exactly what you searched for but are actually the same things.

This is a new cross-reference function that we have added to HTP. For example, if you search for Eaton RTLO14613B, you will still get all the Fuller models. You will also note that there are individual model designations for Detroit DDEC versions of the Series 60 engines.

We have renamed "DETROIT 60 SER 12.7" to now match Detroit's naming convention. You will see "DETROIT SERIES 60 12.7 DDEC I" AND "SERIES 60 12.7 DDEC II", etc. There is currently also a "Series 60 12.7 (ALL)" option to allow searching of all old variations.

We are also TEMPORARILY linking each individual DDEC variation to also bring up not just the individual inventory listings but also all the old non-specific models which you are likely using currently.

Over the next 60 days, we will be rolling out a Manufacturer / Model linking utility in ITrack that will help you stay more connected with what models are in use on HTP.Net and allow you to use Model names in the future that don't exactly match our naming convention on HTP but will still be searched through the cross-reference system.

This is a major enhancement for allowing you to manage your inventory and identify components the way that works best for you and your workers in your facility while still making all your inventory available through HeavyTruckParts.Net under our naming convention.
